

INVITATION

Pastor: They were bringing children to Jesus so that Jesus might touch them, and the disciples rebuked them. But when Jesus saw it, Jesus was indignant, and said to them,

Congregation: "Let the children come to me, do not hinder them; for to such belongs the realm of God. Truly, I say to you, whoever does not receive the realm of God like a child shall not enter it."

Pastor: And Jesus took them in His arms and blessed them, laying His hands upon them.

ADDRESS

Pastor: The sacrament of baptism is an outward and visible sign of the grace of God. In as much as the promise of the gospel is not only to us but also to our children. As parents, we accept responsibility on behalf of our children to nurture them, encourage them, support them and guide them into a lifelong relationship with God through the birth, life, death, and resurrection of Christ. Just as the promise of God was given to Abraham that God would be our God if we would set ourselves apart from the world and follow Him. We see in scripture how God provided through water the restoration of His people. Moses was placed in a basket on the water, Moses led the Israelite people through the Red Sea, and Joshua led the Israelite people through the Jordan River to the Promised Land. It was Jesus that was baptized by John the Baptist, in the Jordan anointing Him for ministry on this earth. Baptism has continued to be a symbol of commitment to raising and nurturing children in Christ that are brought forward.

ADDRESS TO THE PARENT(S) & GODPARENT(S)

Pastor: Do you desire to have your child baptized into the faith and family of Jesus Christ?

Parent(s): We do.

Pastor: Will you encourage this child to renounce the powers of evil and to receive the freedom of a new life in Christ?

Parent(s): We will, with the help of God.

Pastor: Will you teach this child that he/she may be led to profess Jesus Christ as Lord and Savior?

Parent(s): We will, with the help of God.

Pastor: Do you promise, according to the grace given you, to grow with this child in the Christian faith, to help this child to be a faithful member of the church of Jesus Christ, by celebrating Christ's presence, by furthering Christ's mission in all the world, and by offering the nurture of the Christian church so that he/she may affirm his/her baptism?

Parent(s): We do, with the help of God.
