Pastor: As Jesus has commissioned us to Make Disciples, will you seek to be a disciple of Christ, live like Him, and seek to nurture others to do the same and be like Christ?

Pastor: Hearing these confessions of faith by these individuals, do you, as a Community of Faith, renew your belief in the presence, work, and call of Christ in your lives?
