Sunday School will resume on September 10th – Rally Day!

Make plans to attend the classes of your choice.

May we be hungry to learn so that we may be equipped to share. Sunday school sign-up is located at the church entrance. This is for planning purposes, please come even if you don't get signed up!

Toddlers – Kindergarten will meet on the stage in the Fellowship Hall. Teachers Erin, Betsy, and Jen will be working through the Top 50 Instant Bible Lessons for Preschool curriculum. Craig and John will be assisting as the kids work through crafts, memory verses, stories, and reading through scripture of the weekly topics.

Grades 1-3 will be in the middle section of the Fellowship Hall.

Grades 4-6 will be outside the kitchen in the Fellowship Hall. They will start the year by highlighting what they learned last year (the latter half of Genesis: Abraham to Joseph) by watching a movie and having a fun review game. Then they will move into the book of Exodus, which will be the concentration for most of the year up to Easter. A devotional page that goes with each main lesson is typically utilized, and they reflect on those devotionals in journals and discuss them as a group. Lots of interactive learning will take place!

Grades 7-12 will be in the Sunshine Room. Their game plan for this year's Sunday school is to tackle the gospels and Acts of the Apostles! They are planning to really jump into the parables, Jesus, and Paul's teachings/journey!

Adult Class #1 will be in the Kitchen. This class will have a series of teachings "Through the Bible" by Les Feldick. He is a farmer rancher who loves to teach straight out of the Bible. No workbook or homework is required for our class, just bring your Bible!

Adult Class #2 will be in the room beside the Sound booth at the back of the sanctuary and will be studying the Book of Romans for a 12-week series. You will have a study book.

INVITATION

Pastor: *They were bringing children to Jesus so that Jesus might touch them, and the disciples rebuked them. But when Jesus saw it, Jesus was indignant, and said to them,*

Congregation: *“Let the children come to me, do not hinder them; for to such belongs the realm of God. Truly, I say to you, whoever does not receive the realm of God like a child shall not enter it.”*

Pastor: *And Jesus took them in His arms and blessed them, laying His hands upon them.*

ADDRESS

Pastor: *The sacrament of baptism is an outward and visible sign of the grace of God. In as much as the promise of the gospel is not only to us but also to our children. As parents, we accept the responsibility on behalf of our children to nurture them, encourage them, support them, and guide them into a lifelong relationship with God through the birth, life, death, and resurrection of Christ. Just as the promise of God was given to Abraham that God would be our God if we would set ourselves apart from the world and follow Him. We see in scripture how God provided through water the restoration of His people. Moses was placed in a basket on the water, Moses led the Israelite people through the Red Sea, and Joshua led the Israelite people through the Jordan River to the Promised Land. It was Jesus that was baptized by John the Baptist, in the Jordan anointing Him for ministry on this earth. Baptism has continued to be a symbol of commitment to raising and nurturing children in Christ that are brought forward.*

ADDRESS TO THE PARENT(S) & GODPARENT(S)

Pastor: *Do you desire to have your child baptized into the faith and family of Jesus Christ?*

Parent(s): *We do.*

Pastor: *Will you encourage this child to renounce the powers of evil and to receive the freedom of a new life in Christ?*

Parent(s): *We will, with the help of God.*

Pastor: *Will you teach this child that he/she may be led to profess Jesus Christ as Lord and Savior?*

Parent(s): *We will, with the help of God.*

Pastor: *Do you promise, according to the grace given you, to grow with this child in the Christian faith, to help this child to be a faithful member of the church of Jesus Christ, by celebrating Christ’s presence, by furthering Christ’s mission in all the world, and by offering the nurture of the Christian church so that he/she may affirm his/her baptism?*
